3.	Vice-President & Executive Dean report	 Focussing on load. Law has had large growth in enrolments. Attended inaugural PAFC Graduation Ceremony. Sports Management enrolment numbers have increased. International student numbers are significantly down across all universities due to slow visa approval process.

5.	Enrolments and load – Dean (Education)	 Chris provided an overview of enrolments and load, noting: Daily S1 load tracking above same time last year. Against budget is not as positive. Load targets down across the College. Strategies are in place. Admitted but not enrolled students have been emailed. Focus has been on Business students. Criminology students will be contacted next. International onshore Business students of most concern. Early engagement needed. Intercept students who fail two topics. Two new course concepts were approved. 	
6.	Strategic choices and load – Dean (People and Resources)	 Vipul provided an overview of load and strategic initiatives, noting: Business – 11 initiatives. Load likely to be similar to 2023. Government –2 main initiatives, school visits and industry. Expecting to achieve about 80% of load target. Criminology – 2 main initiatives, school visits and attrition. Likely to achieve 95% to 100% of load target. Law – Two main initiatives, CALD/low socio economic market and JD market. Should hit target.
