

## Education Capacity Building Grants

Dear Colleagues,

We are pleased to announce the availability of another round of grants to support activities that build capacity for improved teaching and learning in our college. Grants can contribute to a range of activities including building educational capacity in response to the needs of rural and remote communities, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, our social vision, professional development and teaching and learning initiatives.

While individual grants will be considered, working with a team across the CMPH is also encouraged.

Examples include:

- Grant to support a teaching and learning innovation
- Scholarship to participate in an activity developing relevant skills and networks
- Grant to support development of a new accredited course
- Contribution to the cost of undertaking education-related study

Grants of up to \$20,000 are available. Prior to submitting your grant application please also consider opportunities for funding professional development from other grants including the Professional Staff Development Fund.

Submit your proposal on the attached form, containing:

- a brief summary of your request
- an outline of deliverables and proposed timelines
- evidence of how this proposal aligns with objectives of capacity building grant funds to improve education and training in the College
- details of funding required
- expected outputs or outcomes, explaining how they link to the University's strategic plan and College priorities
- any other comments in support of your application

Applications should consist of

- completed application form (maximum two pages)
- brief CV (maximum one page per applicant)
- up to two pages of additional supporting information, if required.

Successful applicants will be required to submit a quarterly update on progress form detailing progress of achieving project outcomes and expenditure.

Capacity Building grant funding allocations must be expended within the calendar year of the funding.

Please note if you conclude your tenure prior to the completion of your capacity building grant, you
