2025 Postgraduate Research Student Maintenance (RSM)

1. Purpose of Research Student Maintenance

- Research Student Maintenance (RSM) is offered by the College Research Committee. It assists with the cost of research projects being undertaken by Postgraduate students completing a Higher Degree by Research (HDR).
- The RSM allocation is a grant-in-aid for maintenance and consumables. The amount offered is a contribution to the total maintenance costs and may not cover all expenses associated with a HDR research project.
- A HDR student is eligible to apply for up to \$2000 per year of FTE candidature to a maximum of \$6000 during the normal enrollment period (up to 3 years for PhD; 2 years for Master of Science by Research or Master of Surgery: 1 year for Master of Clinical Education by Research)

2. Eligibility

- RSM will only be awarded to candidates enrolled in a Higher Degree by Research in the College of Medicine and Public Health.
- Students who upgrade their Postgraduate qualification (e.g. from Masters to PhD) are only entitled to a maximum of three FTE years of RSM (i.e. the years spent on the former degree are counted towards the third year FTE RSM limit of the PhD).
- The RSM allowance is calculated as follows:
 - Full-time students enrolled for two semesters in one year will receive the maximum allowable amount of RSM;
 - Part-time students will receive half the maximum allowable amount of RSM;
 - Students enrolled full time for one semester will receive half the maximum allowable amount of RSM.

3. Acceptable use of RSM funds

- First year Postgraduate Higher Degree by Research students may elect to receive a new laptop computer for use during their candidature. The College RSM Administrator will process these RSM requests and allocate funds (equivalent to one year FTE of RSM) to the supervisor. The supervisor accepts responsibility for purchasing, dispatching and maintaining laptops loaned to Higher Degree by Research students. This must be done in accordance with College procedures and <u>Flinders University Information & Digital Services (IDS)</u> procurement guidelines.
- The RSM allocation may also be used for:
 - Chemicals/reagents
 - Subject payments
 - Minor equipment
 - Photocopying
 - o Software
 - Slides, microfilms
 - Stationery, disks, tapes
 - Computer ink
 - Transcription
 - Survey questionnaires
 - Consumer involvement activities

- Travel within Australia to attend Flinders University for Research Week
- Australian field travel
- International field travel for data collection purposes
- Student Conference Travel expenses (subject to the student accepted to present a paper or poster)
- Open Access publication fees only in Q1 ranked journals in the latest SCImagoranking when student is the first author. Please refer to <u>http://www.scimagojr.com/journalsearch.php</u>



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4. Unacceptable use of RSM funds

The RSM allocation must not be used for costs associated with:

- Purchasing additional computers
- Membership subscriptions
- Training courses
- o Workshops
- Publications (*Refer to the exception listed in Section 3*)
- Thesis production
- Student Finance offers a <u>Thesis Allowance</u> to assist with thesis production costs
- Conference Travel (*Refer to the exception listed in Section 3*)
 - <u>Scholarships</u> are available to assist with Research Student Conference Travel expenses.
 - Students who wish to undertake an overseas field trip should apply to Scholarship Services for a <u>Research Students Overseas Field Trip Grant</u>.

5. Submission of applications

• Applications must be submitted by email to <u>cmph.research@flinders.edu.au</u> as soon as possible within the 2025 calendar year.

6. Spending RSM funds

- The student's supervisor is responsible for ensuring that RSM funds are expended in the best interests of the student and their progress.
- Funds may not be used under any circumstances to finance travel by the supervisor.
- Funds are not automatically allocated. An application form is required each year.
- If you do not submit an application in the current year, previous year allocations cannot be given in retrospect.
- The balance of the RSM account will carry forward into the next year for use.
- Expenses out of scope from guidelines email <u>cmph.research@flinders.edu.au</u> for further clarification and consideration.
- The College Research Committee may audit RSM accounts at any time.
