

# Flinders Health and Medical Research Institute Visiting Speaker Program

#### **Purpose and aims**

This program provides funds to host a visiting researcher and/or potential research partner for a short visit (generally 1-2 days) at Flinders University. The intention is that the visiting researcher will deliver a seminar open to staff and students and hosted by the College of Medicine and Public Health (CMPH). This program aims to:

- Support the development of research partnerships and relationships with researchers external to Flinders
- Enhance researcher and postgraduate student development by promoting discussions with researchers from other institutions
- Enhance the external profile of research at Flinders University.

### **Funding**

A maximum of \$1,200 is available per visitor. Funds are intended to cover the costs of domestic travel, accommodation and light catering for a seminar or lunch.

#### **Eligibility**

Applicants must be an academic staff member or hold full academic status\* in the College of Medicine and Public Health.

\*Academic staff members in other Colleges at Flinders with status in CMPH are not eligible to apply.

#### Criteria for the award of funding

- Relevance of the visitor's field of research / expertise to research at Flinders University and the host team
- Standing of the proposed visitor in their respective field, judged relative to opportunity
- Breadth of likely interactions with researchers in CMPH.

Applications will be reviewed by a Selection Committee comprised of research leaders and peers from CMPH.

#### **Conditions of funding**

- The maximum amount of funding available is up to \$1,200 per visitor
- A visitor supported by the Visiting Speaker Program must deliver a research seminar at a Flinders University campus, open to staff and students
- The seminar must be advertised in the CMPH weekly newsletter
- Funds must be used as outlined in the proposed budget
- Receipt of a Visiting Speaker Program grant does not preclude staff from applying for other research support programs for a different purpose in the same year.

## **Submission of applications**

Applicants must complete the Visiting Speaker Program Application Form at least 4 weeks prior to the scheduled visit. Well justified late applications will be considered in exceptional circumstances. Retrospective funding will not be considered.

Applications much include:

- The proposed visit schedule, including seminar details, outlining the breadth of interactions with researchers in CMPH
- A brief justification outlining the relevance to, and benefits of, the visit to researchers in CMPH, including the standing of the visitor in their field. (Maximum 300 words).
