

CNHS RAP WORKING GROUP ACTION PLAN 2024 – 2025

Flinders University first developed a Reconciliation Action Plan (RAP) in 2020, with an updated plan currently for 2023-2025 (https://www.flinders.edu.au/content/dam/images/reconciliation-action-plan/OISE_RAP_2023_Final_web.pdf). The action plan sets its path to reconciliation, aligns with the University 2025 Strategic plan and outlines Flinders University's commitment to engaging with Indigenous Australians, students, staff, and the community, respecting Indigenous knowledge systems and perspectives and progressing Indigenous advancement in education, research, employment and wellbeing.

The development of the CNHS RAP Working Group Action plan is to respond to selected deliverables in the Flinders University RAP (see action plan below). The deliverables are measured and reported annually to the Office of Indigenous Strategy and Engagement. The CNHS RAP Working Group also meets with the overall Flinders University RAP Network for three workshops each year. The intent of this workshop is to meet with other RAP working groups from around the university.

Acknowledgement of Country

We recognise the First Peoples across these unceded Lands on which we live and work. We celebrate Kaurna Peoples' deep connection to Country, millennia of storytelling, and their important contributions to community and university. We reflect on the continued impact of government policies and clinical practices and recognise our responsibility to work together to improve cultural outcomes.

The RAP Working Group is guided by the principles and practices which have sustained generations of First Peoples. These practices express a way of knowing, being and doing that is anchored in First Nations knowledges. These values, behaviours and systems of knowledge have sustained First Nations communities in a way which sets Aboriginal-led approaches aside from others. These approaches look to the critical role of our relationships, and the fabric of our kinship and cultural practices embedded within and across communities, including global communities.

In a joint effort, we contribute commitment to reconciliation and ensure our College Reconciliation Action Plan articulates how our staff (and students) will engage in reconciliation action and contribute to greater unity in the community we serve. Our core theme is active allyship and we are deeply interested in extending our capacity to enact it. At its heart, reconciliation is about strengthening relationships between Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples and non-Indigenous peoples, for the benefit of all Australians.
