There are two Learning and Teaching Program Award schemes in 2023:

- CEPSW Teaching Excellence Awards
- CEPSW Innovation in Learning and Teaching Awards

1. CEPSW TEACHING EXCELLENCE AWARDS

Purpose

The CEPSW Teaching Excellence Awards are designed to recognise and reward teaching excellence and reflect a commitment to:

1. Student success and wellbeing
2. Innovative and flexible curriculum and resource design that meets the needs of students
3. Working with industry to ensure relevant, contemporary, and high-quality student learning
4. Educational approaches and/or curriculum that meets the needs of Rural, Regional, Remote communities
5. Education that demonstrates alignment and impact with RAP deliverables and enhanced Indigenous student experience and participation
6. Teaching and curriculum approaches and improvements that are research informed, evidence based, and based on the scholarship of learning and teaching.

Scope of Awards

Three (3x1) CEPSW Teaching Excellence Awards will be recognised in any year, with one recipient in each of the following categories:

1. A team or course initiative
2. Individual Academic staff (continuing or contracted)
3. Individual Academic staff (casual academic teaching)

These three awards are each \$2000 in value, to be used for purposes that will support the ongoing enhancement of teaching and educational quality.

Application Process

Applicants should submit a succinct claim of excellence in teaching which clearly outlines their approach, evidence and impacts against two of the listed areas above. The application should not exceed four pages.

Applications should be sent to cepsw.deaneducation@flinders.edu.au by **28 July 2023**, after which a panel will be convened to make assessment.

Obligations of Award Recipients

Recipients will be expected to host a scholarly workshop for colleagues from across the College, facilitated by the Dean (Education). Recipients will also be encouraged, as appropriate to develop a University Application for the [Vice-Chancellor's Teaching Excellence Awards](#).

2. CEPSW INNOVATION IN LEARNING AND TEACHING AWARDS

Purpose

This award scheme is designed to spotlight agile, responsive, and enterprising teaching practices in which staff and students are committed to excellence. We encourage teaching innovation with approaches to teaching and learning that have a paramount focus on student success and promote Flinders University as an international leader in educational innovation, advanced learning technologies and learning analytics.

Scope of Awards

In 2023, there are three (3x1) CEPSW Innovation in Learning and Teaching Awards, with one recipient in each of the following categories:

1. Innovative initiatives to promote excellence in student learning
2. Leadership and support of staff in Learning and Teaching with focus on student success
3. Teaching & learning that promotes Flinders University as an international leader in educational innovation

All staff, regardless of classification as Academic, Professional, Continuing, Contract or Casual are eligible to be nominated for these awards. It is the nature of contribution that is likely to vary.

Each award is worth \$1000 and should contribute to an increase in professional knowledge, way of working and/or enhancement of practice.

Application Process

Nominations should be submitted in the form of a **5-minute video**. The video should provide a minimum of three claims with supporting examples and evidence against one category.

Applications should be sent to cepsw.deaneducation@flinders.edu.au by **28 July 2023**, after which a panel will be convened to make an assessment.

Obligations of Award Recipients

Recipients will be expected to contribute to a scholarly workshop for colleagues from across the College, facilitated by the Dean (Education). Recipients may also be encouraged, as appropriate, to develop a University application for the [Vice-Chancellor's Teaching Excellence Awards](#).
