Margins

Top – 2cm Bottom – 2cm Left – 2cm Right – 2cm

Paper A4

If you are printing your thesis for binding, ask the binders for their layout specifications.

Styles

Normal

Size – 11 or 12 Colour – Automatic Alignment – Left Paragraph spacing – 0 Before & 12 After Line spacing – 1.5 lines or double

Heading 1

Font – as above Size – 16 Font style – Bold Font Effects – All caps Alignment – Centred Paragraph spacing – 0 Before & 24 After Line spacing – Single Tick, Don't add space between paragraphs

Heading 2

Font – as above Size – 14 Font style – Bold Alignment – Left Paragraph spacing – 15 Before & 12 After Line spacing – Single Tick, Don't add space between paragraphs

Caption

Font as above Size - 10 or 11 Font style - Bold Paragraph spacing - 6 Before & 12 After Line spacing – Single

Fonts

Sans-Serif fonts Arial - minimum 11 Calibri - minimum 12 Verdana - minimum 11

These fonts have been selected based on compatibility between PC and Mac, and readability for common screen reading/accessibility software.

Heading 3

Font – as above Size – 12 Font style – Bold Alignment – Left Paragraph spacing – 12 Before & 9 After Line spacing – Single Tick, Don't add space between paragraphs

Heading 4

Font – as above Size – 12 Font style – Bold and Italic Alignment – Left Paragraph spacing – 9 Before & 6 After Line spacing – Single Tick, Don't add space between paragraphs

Quote

Font – as above Size – 10 or 11 Alignment – Left Indentation – between 0.63 and 1.27 cm left and right Paragraph spacing – 6 Before & 18 After Line spacing – Single

Note: If you find that a frame or box appears around text within your document, modify the affected style by select **Remove frame** under the **Frame** menu.
