### 4 – **Enroll** Biometric Authenticator. Use Microsoft Edge or Google Chrome or Safari for the best experience. Select **Setup** and **Enroll**

#### Set up multifactor authentication

Your company requires multifactor authentication to add an additional layer of security when signing in to your Okta account



#### Security Key or Biometric Authenticator

Use a security key (USB or bluetooth) or a biometric authenticator (Windows Hello, Touch ID, etc.)







5 – When prompted for a Security key setup. Select Cancel for the biometrics authenticator option

### Troubleshooting

- Only YubiKey 5 and newer is supported when choosing to user the security key option. Use Face ID (iPhone), Touch ID (MacBook), Fingerprint (Android), Windows Hello (Windows 10/11) if you have these options available
- If your phone fails to create a passkey, try using a different browser: Microsoft Edge, Google Chrome or Safari and try again by selecting Use a different device on the next screen
- The authenticator may timeout after a few minutes. Just retry by signing into the Okta dashboard again
- If you are signing in from your computer using your phone as a biometric authenticator, your phone needs to be next to the computer you are using
