This guide explains how to add or remove Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) from your public Research @ Flinders profile.

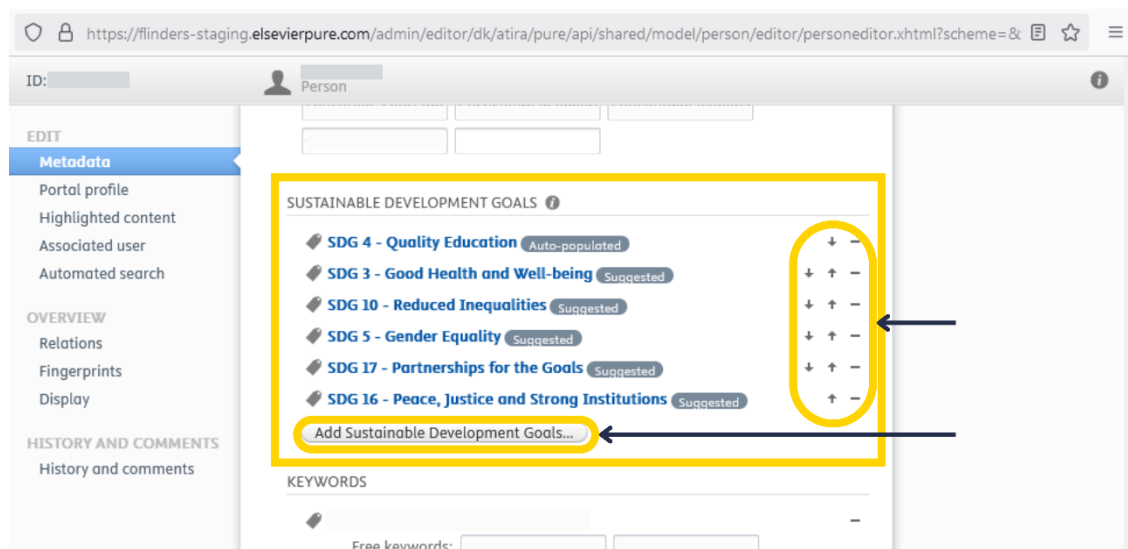

Please note: SDGs harvested from Scopus cannot be deleted, only hidden.

Additionally, Scopus-sourced SDGs attached to your research outputs cannot be edited.

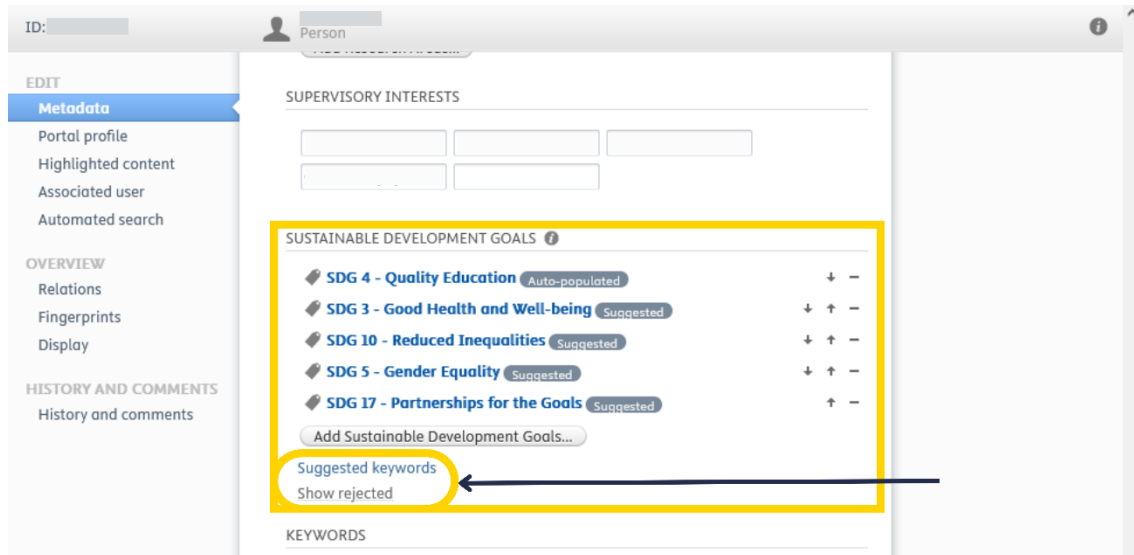
### Process:

1. To access your profile, log in to **ResearchNow** via [Okta](#).
2. Navigate to Personal tab and choose Edit Profile.
3. Scroll down to the Sustainable Development Goals section.

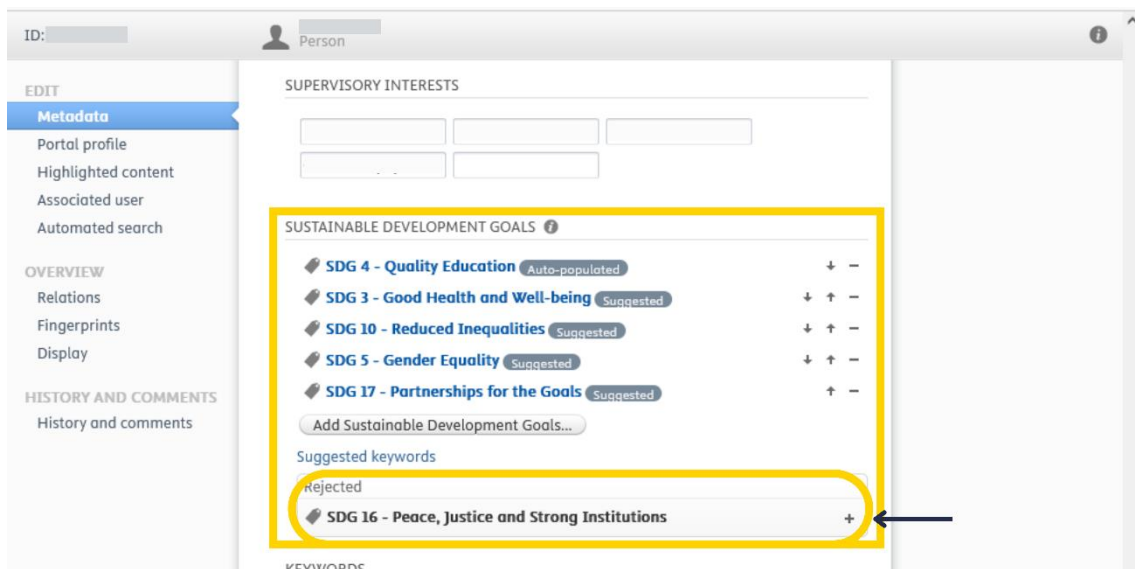


4. To add an SDG, click the grey “Add Sustainable Development Goals” button below the list and select the relevant goal(s) from the dropdown.
5. Use the up and down arrows to reorder SDGs currently visible on your public profile, or the minus sign to hide any from public view. Hiding an SDG does not delete it; it just removes it from the public portal.

6. Click "Show rejected" below your visible SDGs to view those you've hidden.



7. To restore a removed SDG, click the plus sign next to it.

8. When you are done, click "Save and Close" at the bottom of your screen.
